Her sculpture work is impressive. Many of the large-in-scale pieces reanimate, three-dimensionally, the compositions and mannerism of the great Thomas Hart Benton. Her exhibition at Hope Gallery will feature many of her delightful and charming smaller figurative pieces along with her paintings. Rozhon references a number of artists as inspiration: painter John Sloan, photographer Walker Evans, and sculptor Tilman Riemenschneider, among others.

While Hope Gallery retains star artists like Rozhon, it also champions lesser-known talent. Wheeler is one of the most recent additions to Trezvant's artist roster. She's been with Hope Gallery since 2011 and has also exhibited at the Bristol Museum of Art.
